III. 2018 Budget Ratification

A. 2018 Budget and ballot return review

Budget ratification ballots were reviewed. 29 ballots were received in favor of the 2018 proposed budget and 3 ballots were received opposing the 2018 budget.

B. Owner comments

A Formal roll call of each unit number was conducted to solicit comments from all Owners present in person and by phone. Comments from both Owners present and as received on ballots were reviewed. One comment received was, "what were the reasons for the Owners who opposed the Ratification". It was noted that comments were received expressing disappointment with the removal of the prepaid dues discount. The Board reported that this was not an easy decision. However, the discount resulted in what equated to a \$7600 "expense" each year; if the discount would have been left in place, dues would have had to have been increased accordingly to fund the \$7600. It was noted that Owners are permitted, as a convenience, to pay the full annual dues in January. It was also noted that an "ACH" automatic monthly dues payment option is available for
